1 Engaging with Parents

Florida Tax Credit Scholarship Program (FTC)

Provides financial assistance to low-income students, allowing them to attend private schools. Eligible students must meet income requirements and demonstrate a need for financial assistance. The program covers tuition and fees for participating private schools.

Hope Scholarship

Offers educational options for students who have been victims of bullying or other harmful incidents in public schools. Eligible students can receive a scholarship to attend a private school or transfer to another public school. The program focuses on providing a safe and supportive learning environment for these students.

Family Empowerment Scholarship (FES)

Empower families by providing them with the opportunity to choose the educational setting that best meets their child's needs. Eligible students include those from lower-income families or students with unique abilities. The program provides funding for tuition, fees, transportation, and other educational expenses.

New Worlds Reading Scholarship Accounts Program

A scholarship initiative that promotes literacy and reading skills among eligible students in Florida. The program provides financial assistance to students in grades 3-5 who struggle with reading. The scholarship can be used for tutoring, specialized educational materials, and other resources to improve reading abilities.

Federal funding opportunities available to support K-12 students in Florida

Title I Grants

Provide funding to schools with a high percentage of students from low-income families. The funds can be used for improving academic achievement, providing additional instructional support, and promoting parental involvement. Eligibility is determined based on the percentage of low-income students in a school or district.

21st Century Community Learning Centers (CCLC) Grants

Support the establishment of community learning centers that offer academic enrichment activities during non-school hours. These centers provide students with a safe and supportive environment and offer a range of programs, including tutoring, mentoring, arts, and career exploration.

Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) Grants

Support the provision of special education and related services to students with disabilities. These funds can be used to develop and implement Individualized Education Programs (IEPs), provide assistive technology, support professional development, and enhance parental involvement. Eligibility is based on the presence of students with disabilities in a school or district.

Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP) Grants

Support the development and implementation of magnet school programs that promote diversity, academic excellence, and specialized curriculum. These funds can be used to enhance instructional strategies, improve student outcomes, and expand school choice options. Eligibility is based on the presence of magnet schools in a district.

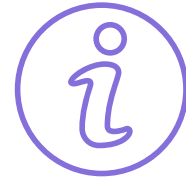
English Learner (EL) Grants

Provide funding to support English language instruction and support services for students with limited English proficiency. These funds help schools implement programs and strategies to help English learners succeed academically. Eligibility is based on the number of English learners in a school or district.
